

**PRESS RELEASE**

Sorry friends, Axis My India couldn't call Bihar Election correctly.

No Excuses, time to learn more and hone our technique.

Our Initial takeaways from the analysis so far:

1. Overall female voter turnout was 5.13% more than male (This fact was available in Public domain only post Exit Poll) which swung the polls in NDA's favor.
2. Female voted at least 5.13% more in favor of NDA.
3. **Voters Turnout** - In **First phase, Men** voted **2.47%** more than Women but **6.29% & 10.64%** more **women** voted than men in **Second** and **Third Phase**, respectively.
4. Axis My India Predictions are exactly in line with results of the First Phase but went amiss for the Second and Third phase.
5. Covid-19 restrictions limited our numbers of women voter Interviews.
